



Frequently Asked Questions – RON

1. What is Remote Online Notarization (RON)?

- Remote Online Notarization, or RON, allows you to have your documents notarized online using secure audio-visual technology, no matter where you are in the U.S. or abroad.

2. Is online notarization legal?

- Yes! RON is legal and recognized in Rhode Island and many other states. Your notarized document will be just as valid and legally binding as an in-person notarization.

3. What platform do you use for remote notarizations?

- Ocean Notary uses BlueNotary, a secure and fully compliant online notarization platform. Your session is recorded and encrypted to ensure safety and legal validity.

4. What do I need for a remote notarization?

- A valid and unexpired government-issued photo ID
- A computer, tablet, or smartphone with a camera and microphone
- A stable internet connection
- Your document in digital format (PDF preferred)

5. Can I use RON for any document?

- Most documents can be notarized online, but some exceptions may apply depending on state or recipient requirements. I'll review your document first to confirm eligibility.

6. How do I book a remote notarization?

7. How much does it cost?
