

Frequently Asked Questions - Notarizations

1. What is a Notary Public?

 A notary public is a commissioned official who verifies identities and witnesses the signing of important documents to help prevent fraud.

2. What types of documents can be notarized?

- Ocean Notary can notarize a wide range of documents, including:
 - Power of Attorney
 - Wills and Trusts (excluding those requiring attorney supervision)
 - Real Estate forms
 - School and sports forms
 - Medical documents
 - Travel consent letters
 - Business contracts
 - o And more...

3. Do I need to bring identification?

- Yes. A valid, government-issued photo ID is required.
 - Driver's license
 - Passport
 - o State ID
 - Military ID
- Please ensure your ID is unexpired. While Rhode Island law permits the use of IDs expired
 within the last three years, Ocean Notary requires all clients to present a current, unexpired
 government-issued ID at the time of notarization. If you have unique circumstances, feel free
 to reach out, I am happy to review on a case-by-case basis.

4. Can Ocean Notary provide witnesses if needed?

• Yes, Ocean Notary can provide witnesses for an additional fee. Just let me know in advance so we can coordinate.

5. Can I sign the document before the notary arrives?

• No. Please do not sign your document until you're in the presence of the notary. The notary must witness your signature to complete the notarization.

6. Can you come to my home or workplace?

• Yes! As a mobile notary, Ocean Notary can meet you at your home, office, hospital, assisted living facility, or another convenient location.

7. What areas do you serve?

 Ocean Notary serves all of Rhode Island including Bristol, Kent, Newport, Providence, and Washington counties. I provide both in-person and remote online notary services.

8. Do you offer remote online notarization (RON)?

• Yes! I offer secure remote online notarizations for clients anywhere in the U.S. using an audiovisual platform that meets state requirements.
